

















Recycling Instructions for Metsä Wood Packaging materials



As part of Metsä 2030 sustainability strategy and the global effort to reduce the amount of plastics, Metsä Wood has introduced packaging plastic that already contains 30% recycled plastic. This reduces the carbon footprint, as well as customers' costs, due to the omission of the plastic tax. All Metsä Wood packaging materials can be recycled or reused.

All packaging materials are suitable for recycling or reuse.

The PET plastic of cardboard, labels and packaging plastic and rims can be delivered to the general collection of each material. Wood can be used as biofuel. Stretch film made of LDPE plastic is an excellent raw material for the production of recycled plastic.
